CHAPTER. XXV.

An Act to authorize the town of New Canada, in Ramsey county, to borrow money for the purpose of paying a bounty to soldiers.

SECTION 1. Supervisors of said town authorized to issue bonds—for what purpose—when made payable—at what rate of interest.

2. Duty of County Auditor.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION. 1. That for the purpose of enabling the town of New Canada to borrow money to pay the bounty offered by said town to each volunteer enlisting therefrom in the military service of the United States, under the call of the President, the supervisors of said town are hereby authorized to issue bonds, orders, or certificates of indebtedness to an amount sufficient for the purpose, payable in one, two, three and four years, with interest, at a rate not exceeding eight per cent. per annum, and to levy such a tax from time to time as may be necessary to pay such interest and principal, as the same shall become due.

SEC. 2. The county auditor of Ramsey county is hereby authorized to recall the tax duplicate of 1863 from the county treasurer, and extend thereon the tax levied, or which may be levied, by said town for the payment of said bounty, or any portion thereof, and return the same to the treasurer for collection.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

CHAPTER XXVI.

An Act to authorize the Commissioners of the county of Ramsey to issue the bonds of said county, to aid in the construction of a Schoolhouse in the town of McLean, in said county.

- SECTION 1. Board of County Commissioners to issue bonds—when made payable—at what rate of interest—in what sum—for what purpose.
2. Duty of School Committee.
 3. Further duties of said Committee.
 4. School to be under the supervision of the Board of Education of the city of Saint Paul.
 5. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the commissioners of the county of Ramsey, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of said county, payable in twenty years, bearing seven per cent. interest, said interest payable semi-annually, at the county treasurer's office, to the amount of five thousand dollars, with coupons attached, in bonds of not less than one hundred dollars, and not over five hundred dollars each, to aid in the construction of a schoolhouse in the town of McLean, in said county of Ramsey, and adjoining the city limits of St. Paul.

SEC. 2. That it shall be the duty of the school committee of the said county of Ramsey, upon the decision of the said commissioners to issue said bonds, to examine and select suitable grounds for the location of said schoolhouse, which said location shall be in sec-
