CHAPTER XXVI.

An Act to authorize the Commissioners of the county of Ramsey to issue the bonds of said county, to aid in the construction of a Schoolhouse in the town of McLean, in said county.

- SECTION 1. Board of County Commissioners to issue bonds—when made payable—at what rate of interest—in what sum—for what purpose.
2. Duty of School Committee.
 3. Further duties of said Committee.
 4. School to be under the supervision of the Board of Education of the city of Saint Paul.
 5. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the commissioners of the county of Ramsey, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of said county, payable in twenty years, bearing seven per cent. interest, said interest payable semi-annually, at the county treasurer's office, to the amount of five thousand dollars, with coupons attached, in bonds of not less than one hundred dollars, and not over five hundred dollars each, to aid in the construction of a schoolhouse in the town of McLean, in said county of Ramsey, and adjoining the city limits of St. Paul.

SEC. 2. That it shall be the duty of the school committee of the said county of Ramsey, upon the decision of the said commissioners to issue said bonds, to examine and select suitable grounds for the location of said schoolhouse, which said location shall be in sec-

tion thirty-three, township twenty-nine and range twenty-two.

SEC. 3. That it shall be the further duty of said school committee to make, or cause to be made, proper specifications for the building of said schoolhouse; and shall give notice that bids will be received for erecting and finishing said building, either in whole or in parts, and shall let the same, by contract, to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders.

SEC. 4. The said school shall be under the regulations, supervision and direction of the board of education of the city of St. Paul, and the children of the fifth ward of the city of St. Paul shall be admitted to said school, whenever the admittance of such scholars shall not interfere, to the exclusion of the children and scholars of McLean township.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXVII.

An Act authorizing the Board of Education of the town of Minneapolis to levy taxes.

SECTION 1. Board of Education authorized to levy tax—in what sum—for what purpose.

SECTION 1. The board of education of the town of Minneapolis are hereby authorized to levy taxes for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four, and in succeeding years, not exceeding five mills upon the dollar of
