

CHAPTER XL.

An Act for the relief of School District number forty-five, in the County of Houston, and to authorize the County Auditor of said county to extend upon the tax roll for collection, the taxes levied by the legal voters of said district in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-three.

- SECTION 1. County Auditor authorized to levy tax—for what purpose.
 2. Taxes to be legal and valid, how collected.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION. 1. That the county auditor be, and he is hereby authorized, directed and required, on or before the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, to extend on the tax duplicates of 1863, in said county, on the real estate and personal property, in school district number forty-five, in said county, the amount of tax voted by the legal voters of said school district number forty-five, in the month of September, 1863, for the purpose of building a school-house in said district.

Authorized to levy special tax—for what purpose

SEC. 2. That said tax, when extended on the tax duplicates as aforesaid, against the real estate and personal property in said school district number forty-five, shall be legal and valid, and the county treasurer of said county of Houston, shall have the same power to collect said tax by distress and sale, as is now possessed by him in collecting county taxes.

Taxes to be valid—how collected

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
