CHAPTER XLL.

An Act to authorize the town of La Crescent, in Houston county to appropriate money to pay bounties to Volunteers heretofore enlisted in the United States military service.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The legal voters of the township of La Crescent, in Houston county, are hereby authorized, Authorized to levy at their next annual town meeting, or at any meeting called after due notice given for that purpose, to vote a tax upon all the real and personal property in said town, as assessed for the present year, to pay the bounty heretofore raised and paid to volunteers enlisted in the military service of the United States.

Duty of county anditor

a tax-for what

Purpose

SEC. 2. The county auditor shall extend upon the tax duplicate, for the year 1864, in a separate column thereof, the tax so voted, in accordance with section one of this act.

Tax, how collected

Sec. 3. The county treasurer is hereby authorized to collect the said tax in the same manner as other taxes are collected.

Duty of board of supervisors.

SEC. 4. The board of supervisors of said town shall, upon proper evidence furnished of the payment of bounty to volunteers by citizens of said town, draw orders upon the town treasurer of said town, upon the war bounty fund, levied and collected in accordance with the provisions of this act.

Duty of town tremurer

SEC. 5. The town treasurer of said town of La Crescent shall pay all orders drawn upon the war bounty fund, as provided for in section four of this act.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XLII.

An Act to repeal an act entitled "An act authorizing the town of Spring Lake, in Scott County, to levy a tax of five mills on the dollar on all real and personal property, for town purposes."

EECTION 1. Repeal of former act.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That chapter four of the special laws of Repeal of former A.D., 1862, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
