CHAPTER XLVI.

An Act to authorize the Common Council of the city of Wabashaw to reimburse money advanced at the request of said Common Council, in aid of the preliminary survey of the branch of the Saint Paul and Pacific Railroad, from St. Paul to Winona, and to authorize the Common Council of said city to subscribe to the stock of said Railroad to the amount of money so advanced.

- SECTION 1. Authorized to issue city orders—for what purpose.
 2. Authorized to subscribe to the stock in said road—in what amount.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the common council of the city of Wabashaw be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in addition to the powers conferred upon said council by the charter of said city, and acts amendatory thereof, to issue city orders in the usual manner of issuing such orders, to reimburse money advanced by citizens of Wabashaw, so advanced upon the pledge of said common council, to repay the same in aid of and to defray, in part, the preliminary surveys of the branch of the St. Paul and Pacific Railroad, from St. Paul to Winona, and the said common council are required, if necessary, to levy a tax to pay said city orders.

For what purpose
city orders may be
issued

SEC. 2. That the common council of said city be and they are hereby authorized to subscribe the amount of such advance to the capital stock of the branch of the St. Paul and Pacific Railroad from St. Paul to Winona, said stock to be of the paid-in stock of said corporation, and the amount to be so subscribed by said council not to exceed the amount of said advances in aid of said preliminary survey.

CHAPTER XLVII.

An Act to authorize the town of West St. Paul, in Dakota county, to raise money to pay contractors for work and materials in opening Isabelle street, in said town.

- SECTION 1. Authorized to levy a special tax—in what amount—for what purpose.
 2. Duty of County Auditor.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the proper officers be instructed and empowered to levy a special tax in the town of West St. Paul, Dakota county, State of Minnesota, to the amount of not exceeding two hundred and seventy-five dollars, or so much thereof as the supervisors of said town may deem necessary to pay in full the indebtedness of said town to certain contractors for work done and materials furnished in opening and grading Isabelle street, in said town; said work and materials having been ordered by a majority of the
