of the commissioners that may be in attendance on the day so specified, to appoint substitutes.

Expenses, how.

SEC. 4. The expenses incurred in the establishing and surveying of said road, shall be paid by the several counties through which the road may pass.

Compensation

SEC. 5. The said commissioners, two chainmen and one axeman shall receive each one dollar and fifty cents per day, and the surveyor three dollars per day, for the number of days employed by them under the provisions of this act.

SEC. 6. The map or plat, or survey of said road shall be filed by said commissioners in the offices of the several registers of deeds of the counties through which the road may pass, on or before the first day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect from and after its

passage.

## CHAPTER LV.

An Act to re-locate and re-establish a State Road from the ferry on the Minnesota River, at Bloomington, to the ferry on the Mississippi River, at Fort Snelling, in Hennepin County.

SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed—for what purpose.

Beitenacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Aaron Gould, Samuel S. Good-

rich and Eli B. Ames are hereby appointed commissioners to re-locate and re-establish the road from the commissioners apferry on the Minnesota river, at Bloomington, to the pointed ferry on the Mississippi river, at Fort Snelling, on the most practicable route near the present traveled track.

SEC. 2. Said commissioners, or a majority of them, where to meet shall some time, during the month of March next, meet on said road, at Nine Mile Creek, and proceed to

the discharge of their duties under this act.

SEC. 3. Said commissioners are hereby authorized to employ one surveyor, one axeman and one chain- May employ and all the chain- May employ and all the chain-Provided, Said commissioners, chainmen, and and compensation axeman shall not receive more than one dollar and fifty cents per day, nor the surveyor more than three dollars per day, for their services under this act, which shall be paid by the county of Hennepin.

Said commissioners shall, on or before the To Sie plat of road first day of April next, file an accurate plat of said road in the office of the auditor of said county of Hennepin, and thereafter said road shall be deemed to be located and established.

Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
