

SEC. 4. The expenses of locating said road shall Expenses how paid be paid by the county of Hennepin.

SEC. 5. It shall be the duty of said commissioners to appraise the damages sustained by each owner of Damages sustained—how ascertained land through which said road may pass, and in case any one shall feel himself aggrieved by such appraisal, he may appeal to the county commissioners of Hennepin county, at any time within thirty days, and the said county commissioners shall, at their next annual meeting, determine said appeal as they may deem just.

SEC. 6. Said commissioners shall, on or before the To file plat of road first day of May next, file an accurate plat of said road in the office of the register of deeds in the county of Hennepin, and thereafter said road shall be deemed established.

SEC. 7. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LVIII.

An Act to provide for the location of a State Road from Glencoe, in McLeod County, to some point on the Minnesota River, between Yellow Medicine and Big Stone Lake.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. Ed. White, P. W. Savage and L. G. Simons are hereby appointed commissioners to survey, locate and lay out a State road from Glencoe, in Mc- For what purpose commissioners appointedLeod county, to some point on the Minnesota river, between Yellow Medicine and Big Stone Lake.

SEC. 2. Said commissioners may meet at Glencoe, on any day subsequent to the passage of this act, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed on them by the provisions of this act; and if any one of said commissioners shall be unable to act as such commissioner, the other two shall have power to appoint a substitute.

Expenses how paid

SEC. 3. Each county through which such road passes, shall pay the reasonable expenses of locating the same in such county. *Provided*, That no county shall be liable to pay such expenses, unless the board of commissioners of such county shall assent thereto before such location.

To file plat of road

SEC. 4. The commissioners hereby appointed shall, as soon as practicable after locating said road, file an accurate plat of the same in the office of the register of deeds in each county in which it may run, which said plat shall be the legal evidence of the location of said road.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved March 4, 1864.

An Act to provide for the survey, location and establishment of a State Road from Carimonia, in Fillmore County, to intersect the Winona and Chatfield Road, east of Troy, in Winona County.
