SEC. 2. The said William Scargale Wakelin is hereby constituted the heir-at-law of Scargale Wakelin and Mary Wakelin, his wife, of St. Louis county, and he shall enjoy all the rights and privileges, and be subject to the same care, custody, and control as if he was the child of the said Scargale Wakelin and Mary Wakelin. Declared the legal heir of Scargale Wakelin

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXVII.

An Act to change the name of Georgianna Parker to that of Lillie Belle Ruby.

SECTION 1. Change of name—declared to be the legal heir of Adrian G. Ruby.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the child heretofore known as Georgianna Parker, he and the same is hereby changed to Lillie Belle Ruby, and she is hereby declared to be the legally adopted daughter of Adrian G. Ruby, of the town of Greenvale, county of Dakota, and State of Minnesota, and she shall enjoy all the rights, privileges, and inheritances, and be subject to all the obligations and duties, the same as if she had been the legitimate daughter of the said Adrian G. Ruby, born in lawful wedlock. Change of name—declared the legal heir of Adrian G. Ruby

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXVIII.

An Act to change the name of the town of Watonwan to the name of Garden City.

SECTION 1. Change of name of said town.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the name of the town of Watonwan, in the county of Blue Earth, be and the same is hereby changed to the name of Garden City.
