

## CHAPTER LXIX.

*An Act to change the name of the Township of Sergeant, in the County of Rice, to that of Warsaw.*

- SECTION 1. Change of name of said town.  
2. When act to take effect.

*Beit enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the name of the township of Sergeant, in the county of Rice, be and the same is hereby changed to Warsaw. Change of name of said town

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved March 4, 1864.

## CHAPTER LXX.

*An Act to change the boundary line of Brown County.*

- SECTION 1. Boundary lines of Brown county.  
2. Duties of officers of the counties of Brown, Cottonwood and Redwood.  
3. Who to canvass votes on the proposed change of county lines.  
4. Repeal of acts inconsistent with this act.  
5. When act to take effect.

*Beit enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. The boundary lines of Brown county shall hereafter be as follows :

Boundary lines

Beginning at the intersection of the Minnesota river and the range line between ranges twenty-nine and thirty; thence south, on said line, to the township line between townships one hundred and seven and one hundred and eight; thence west, on said line, to the range line between ranges thirty-five and thirty-six; thence north, on said range line, to the middle of the Minnesota river; thence southeasterly, along the middle of the main channel of the Minnesota river to the place of beginning.

Duties of officers of said counties

SEC. 2. At the time of giving notice of the next general election, it shall be the duty of the officers of the counties of Brown, Cottonwood and Redwood, required by law to give notice of such election, to give notice, in like manner, that at said election a vote will be taken on the question of changing the boundary line of Brown county, in accordance with the provisions of this act. At said election the voters of the counties of Brown, Cottonwood and Redwood, in favor of the change proposed by this act, shall have distinctly written or printed on their ballots,

“For change of boundary line of Brown county.”

And those opposed to said change,

“Against change of boundary line of Brown county.”

The votes shall be canvassed in the same manner, and returned to the same officers by the judges of election of the several townships, as votes for State officers.

Who to canvass votes on the proposed change of county lines

SEC. 3. The county officers to whom the returns are made in said county, shall, within twenty days after said election, canvass the votes returned for and against the change of boundary line, and shall forthwith certify the result of such canvass to the Governor, who, if it appears that a majority of the votes in each of said counties, on the question of changing the boundary line, are in favor of such change, shall make proclamation thereof, by causing to be published, in one newspaper in said county of Brown, that the change proposed by this act has been ratified and adopted by the majority of the electors of said county.

Repeal of inconsistent acts

SEC. 4. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its ratification and adoption by a major-

ity of the voters of said counties, as provided in this act.

## CHAPTER LXXI.

*An Act to change the name of Presbyterian Institute of the Presbytery of St. Paul, and to amend its charter.*

- SECTION 1. Change of name of said Institute—Board of Trustees.
2. All donations to said Institute shall vest in Board of Trustees.
  3. Power of Board of Trustees.
  4. How meeting of said Board may be called—election of officers.
  5. Term of office.
  6. Trustees of said Institute, how appointed.
  7. Vacancies how filled.
  8. All property belonging to the seminary to be free from taxation.
  9. Trustees to make by-laws for their own government.
  10. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the name of the Presbyterian Institute of the Presbytery of St. Paul, be changed to that of "The St. Paul Female Seminary," and that the charter of the same be amended so as to read as follows, viz.: There shall be established in the city of St. Paul an institution of learning, to be known by the name of "The Saint Paul Female Seminary;" and John G. Riheldaffer, John Nicols, Lorenzo Allis, O. B. Turrill, J. C. Caldwell, C. M. Goodsell and James A. McKee, and their successors in office, are hereby created a body corporate, to be known by the name and style of "The Trustees of the St. Paul Female Seminary;" with the right as such, and by such name, of suing and being sued, of contracting and being con-
