A certificate of the lands so selected, describing them and the purposes for which they were what to be deemed selected, under the hand of the commissioner and seal of the State land office shall be received in all courts as evidence of title to said lands in the trustees or other superintending officers of the institutions aforesaid.

## CHAPTER VI.

March 2, 1955.

An Act to provide for the Incorporation of Canals, Slack-Water Navigation Companies and other Companies for the prosecution of works of Internal Improvement.

- SECTION 1. Corporations may be instituted for the construction and operation of canals or alackwater navigation.
  - 2. Persons becoming so associated shall subscribe a statement as follows:-
    - 1. Name of said corporation.
    - 2. General nature of business.
