

In the county of Wabashaw, on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of June and the first Tuesday after the fourth Monday in November, in each year.

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances, process and other proceedings made returnable to the district court in either of the counties mentioned in section one of this act, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to said court at the terms thereof as fixed by this act, and all continuances and notices made or taken to any term of the district court in either of said counties shall be deemed to be made or taken to the terms of said court as the same are fixed by this act, and all motions and other proceedings noticed to be heard at any regular term of said district court, in either of said counties shall be considered and allowed to be noticed for hearing at the regular terms of said court as the same are fixed by this act.

All writs, recognizances, etc., to be returned to said court.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 4. This act to take effect on and after the first day of July, A. D. eighteen hundred and sixty-five.

CHAPTER LXXIV.

*An Act to fix the times of holding the District Court in the Sixth Judicial District.*

March 2, 1865.

- SECTION 1. Time of holding terms of District Court in the Sixth Judicial District.  
 2. All writs, recognizances, etc., deemed to be returned to such court.  
 3. Repeal of inconsistent acts.  
 4. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the several terms of the district

court for the counties of Brown, Blue Earth, Faribault, Martin, McLeod, Nicollet, LeSueur, and Sibley, shall be held at the times following:

Time of holding terms of District Court in said district.

In the county of Brown, on the third Tuesday of June, of each year.

In the county of Blue Earth, on the third Tuesday of May and the first Tuesday of December, of each year.

In the county of Faribault, on the first Tuesday of June, of each year.

In the county of Martin, on the third Tuesday of July, of each year.

In the county of McLeod, on the second Tuesday of September, of each year.

In the county of Nicollet, on the first Tuesday of May, and the first Tuesday of November, of each year.

In the county of Sibley, on the second Tuesday of April, and the second Tuesday after the first Monday of October, of each year.

In the county of LeSueur, on the third Tuesday of March, and on the third Tuesday of September, of each year.

All writs, recognizances, etc., to be returned to said court.

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances and other proceedings made returnable to the district court of any of the said counties, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of such court as the same are fixed by this act, and all continuances, appeals, and notices made or taken to any term of the district court of any of said counties, shall be considered and construed to be made or taken to the terms of such court for the respective counties in which the same shall be pending, as such terms are fixed by this act, and all motions and other proceedings noticed to be heard at any regular term of the district court in either of said counties, shall be allowed and considered to be noticed for hearing at the regular term of said court for the same county as the same is fixed by this act, and not otherwise.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 3. Chapter thirty of the general laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-one, and chapter twenty-six of the general laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, together with all other acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXV.

*An Act fixing the time of holding the general terms of the District Court in Dakota County.* February 28, 1865.

SECTION 1. Time of holding terms of District Court in Dakota County.  
 2. Repeal of inconsistent acts.  
 3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the general terms of the district court in and for the county of Dakota, in the first judicial district, shall be held on the third Tuesday in June, and the fourth Tuesday in January of each year.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
