SEC. 2. That the said Elizabeth Lillis McClosky is hereby declared to be the legally adopted daughter of Archibald McClosky and his wife, Caroline McClosky, of Nicollet county in the State of Minnesota, and shall be subject to all such obligations and duties, and entitled to all such rights, benefits, privileges, advantages and inheritances, as would accrue to the said Elizabeth Lillis McClosky, were she the legitimate child of the said Archibald McClosky, and his wife, Caroline McClosky. Declared legal heir of Archibald McClosky.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CIII.

An Act to change the name of James Franklin Raynor to that of Lewis Marcellus Brown. March 2, 1865.

- SECTION 1. Change of name.
- 2. Declared the legal heir of Luther M. Brown.

Beit enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the name of James Franklin Raynor be, and the same is hereby changed to that of Lewis Marcellus Brown. Change of name.

SEC. 2. The said Lewis Marcellus Brown, a minor, is hereby declared to be the heir at law, and legally adopted son of Luther M. Brown and Eliza J. Brown, of Shakopee, in the county of Scott, and State aforesaid, and subject to all such obligations and duties, and

entitled to all such privileges, advantages and inheritances as would accrue to the said Lewis Marcellus Brown, were he the legitimate son of the said Luther M. Brown and Eliza J. Brown.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Wilson and Margaret Wilson, of Eagle Creek, in the county of Scott, in the State aforesaid, and subject to all such obligations and duties, and entitled to all such privileges, advantages and inheritances, as would accrue to the said Lizze Crawford Wilson, were she the legitimate daughter of the said James C. Wilson and Margaret Wilson.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
