## CHAPTER CIV.

March 2, 1865.

*An Act to change the name of Lizze Rugg to that of Lizze Crawford Wilson.*

- SECTION 1. Change of name.  
 2. Declared the legal heir of James C. Wilson.  
 3. When act to take effect.

*Beit enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

Change of name.

SECTION 1. That the name of Lizze Rugg, be, and the same is hereby changed to that of Lizze Crawford Wilson.

Declared legal heir  
of James C. Wilson.

SEC. 2. The said Lizze Crawford Wilson, a minor, is hereby declared to be the heir at law and legally adopted daughter of James C. Wilson and Margaret Wilson, of Eagle Creek, in the county of Scott, in the State aforesaid, and subject to all such obligations and duties, and entitled to all such privileges, advantages and inheritances, as would accrue to the said Lizze Crawford Wilson, were she the legitimate daughter of the said James C. Wilson and Margaret Wilson.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
