Declared legal heir of Baldasar Petsinger.

SEC. 4. The said Emma Petsinger is hereby constituted an heir at law of Baldasar Petsinger and Barbara Petsinger his wife, of the the town of Hay Creek, County of Goodhuc, and she shall enjoy all the rights and privileges and be subject to the same control as if she were the actual child of the said Baldasar and Barbara Petsinger.

SEC. 5. The said Nancy Jane Bryant is hereby deof Horace Bryant clared to be the legal heir of Horace Bryant and Jane Bryant his wife, of the county of Carver, and she shall enjoy all the rights and privileges, and be subject to the same control as if she were the legitimate child of the said Horace and Jane Bryant.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXII.

March 2, 1865. An Act to change the name of Clara Frances Brown to that of Clara Frances Allen.

SECTION 1. Change of name-declared the legal heir of James S. Allen. 2. When act to take affect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the child heretofore declared legal heir known as Clara Frances Brown, be, and the same is of Januar 8. Allen. hereby changed to that of Clara Frances Allen; and she is hereby constituted and declared to be the legally adopted daughter of James S. Allen and Frances S. Allen, his wife, of the town of Northfield, county of Rice, and State of Minnesota; and she shall enjoy all the rights, privileges and inheritances, and be subject to all the obligations and dutics, the same as if she had been the legitimate daughter of the said James S. Allen and Frances S. Allen, born in lawful wedlock.

SEO. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
