

## CHAPTER LXXIII.

*An Act to legalize and confirm the tax levied in the town of Quincy, Olmsted county, to pay soldiers' bounties for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-three, and the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four and the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five, by the supervisors of said township and authorize the collection of the same.*

- SECTION 1. Confirmation of the action of the Board of Supervisors.  
 2. Taxes, how collected.  
 3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the action of the board of supervisors of the township of Quincy, Olmsted county, in levying a tax on all the taxable property in said township for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-three, and the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four and the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five, to pay bounties to soldiers, is hereby legalized and confirmed.

SEC. 2. The proper officers for the collection of State, county, town, road, special, school, and all other taxes, are hereby authorized to proceed to collect the taxes mentioned in section one of this act, in the same manner and with the same powers, as is conferred upon them for the collection of other taxes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
