

same manner and with the same effect as if the same had been filed within the time in said sections specified.

Failure to file  
not to render in-  
valid.

SEC. 2. No proceedings in which such affidavits have been heretofore received shall be deemed invalid by reason of the failure to file the same within the time prescribed by said section. *Provided*, that nothing herein contained shall be held to take away or affect any vested rights of any person or persons not parties to such proceedings.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XIX.

February 12, 1866 *An Act to amend an act entitled "An act fixing the time of holding terms of the District Courts in the Third Judicial District," approved Feb. 23, 1865. being Chapter LXXIII of the Session Laws of 1865.*

SECTION 1. Amends section 1 of Chapter LXXIII of Session Laws of 1865.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Amends Chapter  
LXXIII of Session  
Laws of 1865.

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter LXXIII of the session laws of 1865, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

SEC. 1. The times of holding general terms of the district court in the third judicial district shall be as follows:

In Olmsted county, on the fourth Monday of April and the first Monday of October in each year.

In Winona county, on the fourth Monday of March and the second Monday of September of each year.

In Houston county, on the first Tuesday after the second Monday of May, and the first Tuesday after the third Monday of October in each year.

In the county of Fillmore, on the first Tuesday after the third Monday of May, and the first Tuesday after the second Monday of November in each year.

In the county of Wabashaw, on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of June, and the first Tuesday after the fourth Monday of November in each year.

## CHAPTER XX.

*An Act to amend an "Act to fix the times of holding the District Court in the Sixth Judicial District."* February 9, 1866

- SECTION 1. Fixing the time of holding circuit court for Sixth Judicial District.
2. Regulates when writs, &c., are made returnable; how motions are to be made.
  3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That so much of section one of an act fixing the times of holding the district court in various counties in the sixth judicial district, approved March 2d, 1865, as relates to the counties of Le Sueur, Sibley and Martin, be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read:

When Court to be held in Sixth District.

In the county of Le Sueur, on the first Tuesday of March, and on the third Tuesday of September, of each year.

In the county of Sibley, on the second Tuesday of April, and on the first Tuesday of October, of each year.
