

In the county of Martin, on the third Tuesday of October of each year.

Where writs re-
turnable.

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances, and all other papers and proceedings made returnable to the district court of any of the said counties, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of such court as the same are fixed by this act; and all continuances, appeals and notices made or taken to any term of the district court of any of said counties, shall be considered and construed to be made or taken to the terms of such court, for the respective counties in which the same shall be pending, as such terms are fixed by this act; and all motions and other proceedings noticed to be heard at any regular term of said court, in either of said counties, shall be allowed and considered to be noticed for hearing at the regular terms of said court for the same county, as the same is fixed by this act, and not otherwise.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval.

CHAPTER XXI.

March 1, 1866.

An Act fixing the time of holding terms of the District Court in Chisago County.

- SECTION 1. Fixes time for holding District Court in Chisago County.
2. Where writs, recognizances, &c., are made returnable.
 3. Repeals all acts inconsistent with this act.
 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there shall be two terms of the

District Court held in the county of Ohisago, in the first judicial district, one term on the first Tuesday of May, and the other on the third Tuesday of October of each year. Where writs returnable.

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances and other proceedings made returnable to the District Court of said county, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of such court as the same are fixed by this act. When terms of court to be held.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed. Repeals acts inconsistent.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXII.

An Act providing Salaries for Clerks of the District Court in certain cases. February 23, 1866

SECTION 1. Provides salaries for clerks of District Court in certain cases.

2. Clerks of District Court to file at certain times statement, under oath, to County Auditor.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. In all counties where the fees of the clerks of the District Court do not exceed five hundred dollars per annum the said clerk shall receive from the county treasurer of his county, unless prohibited by the county commissioners of said county, a sum which, together with the fees of his office, shall be equal to five hundred dollars per annum: *Provided*, the population of such county exceeds five thousand, as shown by last State census. Fixes clerks' salary.
