## CHAPTER XLIV.

An Act to define the boundary line of Pope County February 28,1868 and to provide for its organization.

SECRECA 1. Establishes the boundary line of Pope County.

- 2. Locates the county seat.
- 3. When act to take offect.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The boundary line of Pope county is Boundary of Pope hereby established, and shall hereafter be as follows: county. Beginning at the north-east corner of township one hundred and twenty six (126) north, of range thirty-six (36) west of fifth principal meridian, thence west to the north-west corner of township one hundred and twenty-six (126) north, of range forty (40) west; thence south to the south-west corner of township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range forty (40) west; thence east to the south-east corner of township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range thirty-six (36) west; thence north to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. The county of Pope is hereby declared an Temporarily looganized county, and the county seat thereof tempo-cates county seat rarily located at the town of Stockholm, situated upon the north half of the south-east quarter of section No. eighteen (18), in township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range thirty-seven (37) west.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its

passage.
