

CHAPTER XLIV.

*An Act to define the boundary line of Pope County
and to provide for its organization.* February 28, 1866

SECTION 1. Establishes the boundary line of Pope County.

2. Locates the county seat.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The boundary line of Pope county is hereby established, and shall hereafter be as follows : Boundary of Pope county.
Beginning at the north-east corner of township one hundred and twenty six (126) north, of range thirty-six (36) west of fifth principal meridian, thence west to the north-west corner of township one hundred and twenty-six (126) north, of range forty (40) west; thence south to the south-west corner of township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range forty (40) west; thence east to the south-east corner of township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range thirty-six (36) west; thence north to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. The county of Pope is hereby declared an organized county, and the county seat thereof temporarily located at the town of Stockholm, situated upon the north half of the south-east quarter of section No. eighteen (18), in township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range thirty-seven (37) west. Temporarily locates county seat

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
