

CHAPTER XLIX.

An Act to attach certain territory therein named to the county of Monongalia.

February 21, 1866

SECTION 1. Attaches certain territory to county of Monongalia.

2. Repeals all acts inconsistent with this act.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That so much territory as is embraced in the following boundaries, be, and the same is hereby attached to, and shall become a part of the county of Monongalia:

Attaches certain territory to Monongalia county.

Beginning at the northeast corner of township one hundred and twenty-two north, of range thirty-seven west, and running thence on the township line between townships one hundred twenty-two and one hundred twenty-three, west to the northwest corner of said township; thence along the range line between ranges thirty-seven and thirty-eight, south to the southwest corner of township one hundred twenty north, of range thirty-seven west; thence along the township line between townships one hundred nineteen and one hundred twenty, east to the southeast corner of township one hundred twenty north of range thirty-seven west; and thence north along the range line between ranges thirty-six and thirty-seven to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

Repeals inconsistent acts.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption by a majority of the legal voters of the counties affected thereby, who shall be present and vote thereon at the next general election, and after said adoption shall have been proclaimed by the Governor.
