

CHAPTER LVIII.

An Act making appropriation of money for a contingent fund of immigration, for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six. March 2, 1866.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for a contingent fund of Immigration.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be drawn upon the order of the Governor, and to be applied exclusively to the payment for composing and printing of pamphlets and circulars, for postage, advertising, and for forwarding printed matter under the provisions of an act entitled "an act to organize a system for the promotion of immigration to the State of Minnesota," approved March fourth, eighteen hundred and sixty-four.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
