

CHAPTER LIX.

February 28, 1966 *An Act for the purpose of enlarging the Law Library of the State.*

- SECTION 1.** Appropriation for enlarging Law Library of State.
2. Judges of Supreme Court to draw appropriation.
3. Judges may sell or exchange duplicate copies.
4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriates
money for Li-
brary.

SECTION 1. The sum of five hundred dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of enlarging the law library of the State.

Supreme Court
Judges to expend
appropriation.

SEC. 2. The Judges of the Supreme Court are hereby authorized to draw said sum from the Treasury of the State, and to expend the same in the purchase of such law books as they may deem best.

Powers of Judges

SEC. 3. The said Judges may exchange any duplicate copy of any law book in the State Library, or sell and reinvest the proceeds of any such duplicate copy in the purchase of additional law books.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
