CHAPTER LXII.

An Act making appropriations for expenses of Samuel February 25,18 Aiken and David. L. Buell in contested election case.

Secreca 1. Appropriations for expenses of Samuel Aiken and D. L. Buell.

- 1. Beimburses Samuel Aiken for money expended in contested election
- 2. Reimburses D. L. Buell for similar expenditures.
- 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1. That the following sums of money be Appropriation and the same are hereby appropriated out of any for expenses money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated:

Alken and Buc

1st. To Samuel Aiken for the purpose of reimbursing said Aiken moneys by him expended in paying justices, witnesses, and other officers in case of Aiken vs. Buell, ninety-eight dollars.

2nd. To D. L. Buell, for the purpose of reimbursing said Buell moneys by him expended in paying justices, witnesses and other officers in case of Aiken vs. Buell, fifty-one dollars and fifty-six cents.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
