NUMBER IV.

*A Joint Resolution in relation to the protection of an  
Emigrant Route to Montana Territory.*

February 9, 1866

*Be it Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Min-  
nesota:*

For the protec-  
tion of emigrant  
route to Montana  
Territory.

That the Governor be requested to address Major General John Pope, requesting him, if not incompatible with the interest of the service, to extend the District of Minnesota, so as to embrace within the command of Major General J. M. Corse, Fort Rice, Fort Berthold, and Fort Union, and that he be authorized to give all the protection to emigration from this State to Montana Territory, that may be practicable with the means at his command, when such service will not interfere with his more important duties.
