NUMBER V.

A Joint Resolution of the Legislature of the State February 29,1868 of Minnesota in relation to the Settlement of certain Indians in Minnesota.

Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That our Senators in Congress are instructed and to prevent setour Representatives requested, to employ all honora-tiement of cerble means in their power, and to use their influence in Congress as well as before the departments, to prevent the settlement of certain meritorious Indians upon our frontier, under Section 4 of an act of Congress entitled, "An Act for the removal of the Sissiton, etc., Indians, and for the disposition of their land, in Minnesota and Dakota," approved March 3, 1863.

Resolved, That the Secretary of State forward a certified copy of the foregoing Joint Resolution, and of a Memorial on the same subject, to each of our Sena-

tors and Representatives in Congress. Approved February 28, 1866.
