

CHAPTER CI.

An Act to locate and establish a State road from Wilton, in Waseca county, to Winnebago City in Faribault county. March 1, 1866.

SECTION 1. Nominates commissioners to locate State road from Wilton to Winnebago City.

2. Place and time of meeting of Commissioners.
3. Commissioners may employ surveyor, etc.
4. Commissioners to appraise damages. To file plat.
5. County Commissioners may allow or reject proposals.
6. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That H. A. Buck, N. J. Kremer and J. B. Hill are hereby appointed commissioners to locate, survey and establish a State road from Wilton, in Waseca county, to Winnebago City, in Faribault county. Nominates Commissioners.

SEC. 2. The commissioners shall meet at such place as may be most convenient, on any day subsequent to the passage of this act, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed on them by the provisions of this act; *Provided*, That in the absence of any one of said commissioners the other two shall have power to fill said vacancy by the appointment of some suitable person, who shall have the same authority as is by this act conferred upon said commissioners above named. Commissioners to hold meeting.

SEC. 3. The said commissioners are hereby empowered to employ one surveyor, two chainmen and one axeman. May appoint officers.

SEC. 4. It shall be the duty of the said commissioners to appraise the damages sustained by each owner of land through which said road shall run, and report the same to the board of county commissioners of the county in which said lands are located. Said commissioners shall cause an accurate plat and maps of the survey and location of said road to be made, which Duty of Commissioners.

together with a statement of their appraisal of damages, shall be filed in the office of the county auditor in each of said counties, and thereupon the establishment of said road shall be deemed complete.

Further duties.

SEC. 5. It shall be the duty of said county commissioners to examine any appraisals, and allow or reject the same, as they in their judgment may think best.

Expenses—How defrayed.

SEC. 6. The expenses of surveying, locating and establishing said road, and the damages, if any, shall be paid by the several counties through which said road shall run, in proportion to the distance it shall run in said counties.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

SECTION 1. Nominates Commissioners to locate State Road from Fort Ridgley to Chippewa City

2. Time and place of meeting of Commissioners.
3. Expense of location—how defrayed.
4. Compensation.
5. Plat to be filed.
6. Expenses of surveying how paid.
7. When act to take effect:
