

together with a statement of their appraisal of damages, shall be filed in the office of the county auditor in each of said counties, and thereupon the establishment of said road shall be deemed complete.

Further duties.

SEC. 5. It shall be the duty of said county commissioners to examine any appraisals, and allow or reject the same, as they in their judgment may think best.

Expenses—How defrayed.

SEC. 6. The expenses of surveying, locating and establishing said road, and the damages, if any, shall be paid by the several counties through which said road shall run, in proportion to the distance it shall run in said counties.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CIII.

February 23, 1866 *An Act to locate a State Road from Fort Ridgley, in Nicollet county, to Chippewa City, in Chippewa county.*

SECTION 1. Nominates Commissioners to locate State Road from Fort Ridgley to Chippewa City

2. Time and place of meeting of Commissioners.
3. Expense of location—how defrayed.
4. Compensation.
5. Plat to be filed.
6. Expenses of surveying how paid.
7. When act to take effect:

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appoints Commissioners.

SECTION 1. That D. G. Wilkins, James Carrothers and Diederich Wichman are hereby appointed com-

missioners to locate, mark, survey and establish a State Road from Fort Ridgley, in Nicollet county, by way of Beaver Falls, in Renville county, to Chippewa City in Chippewa county.

Sec. 2. The said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet in the town of Beaver Creek, on the first day of May next, and then proceed to locate and survey said road, and in case all of said commissioners should not be in attendance on that day, as provided in this section, it shall be the duty of who may be in attendance on the day so specified, to appoint substitutes.

Commissioners
to meet.

Sec. 3. The expenses incurred in the establishing and surveying of said road shall be paid by the several counties through which the road may pass, in proportion to the length of such road in said counties.

Expenses—How
defrayed.

Sec. 4. The said commissioners, one chainman and one axeman, shall receive each two dollars and fifty cents per day, and the surveyor the sum allowed by law for the number of days employed by them under the provisions of this act.

Compensation.

Sec. 5. The map or plat, or survey of said road, shall be filed by said commissioners in the office of the several Registers of Deeds of the counties through which the road may pass, on or before the first day of November, 1866.

Plat to be filed.

Sec. 6. The expenses of surveying, locating and establishing said road shall be paid by the counties through or in which said road shall run, in proportion to the distance it shall run in said counties.

Surveys—how
paid for.

Sec. 7. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
