

CHAPTER CXXIII.

*An Act to constitute George Fenton Warner heir at March 1, 1866.
law of Henry E. Warner.*

SECTION 1. Constitutes George Fenton Warner heir at law of Henry E. Warner.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That George Fenton Warner, a minor child of Maria Wright, of Dodge county, be, and he is hereby constituted heir at law of Henry E. Warner, of said county, and shall enjoy all the rights and privileges, and be subject to the same care, custody and control, as if he were the actual and legitimate son of the said Henry E. Warner. Declared heir of Henry Warner.

SEC 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
