

payable at such time or times as to the said trustees of said district shall seem for the best interest of said district.

SEC. 3. The said bonds shall be signed by the director of said district and shall be attested by the clerk thereof. Bonds to be signed.

SEC. 4. The proceeds of the sale of the bonds provided for by this act shall be applied exclusively by the trustees of said district in the purchase of a suitable site and the erection thereon of a proper building for the purpose of common schools in said district. How proceeds to be applied.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXXIII.

An Act to legalize the action of the Trustees of School District No. Fourteen in Faribault county in issuing the bonds of said district to build a school house therein. February 23, 1866

SECTION 1. Legalizes the action of Trustees of School District No. Fourteen of Faribault County.

2. When Act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the action of the trustees of school district No. fourteen in Faribault county in issuing bonds to an amount not exceeding the sum voted by the legal voters, to be raised for the purpose of erecting a school house in said district, be and the same is hereby declared legal and binding upon the inhabitants and tax-payers of said district. Action of Trustees to be legal.

SEC 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXXIV.

March 1, 1866.

An Act to legalize the action of the Board of Trustees of School District No. Thirty-two of the township of Watertown, of the County of Carver, in contracting for the building of a school house in said district, and for other purposes.

- SECTION 1. Legalizes action of Board of Trustees of School District number thirty-two, of Watertown, Carver County.
2. Board authorized to issue bonds for certain purposes.
 3. Trustees to have power to levy special tax to pay interest on bonds.
 4. Who shall sign bonds—clerk to keep record of bonds.
 5. Board of Trustees may issue bonds under certain restrictions.
 6. Chairman of Board to be Director of school district.
 7. When Act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Legalizes acts of Board of Trustees

SECTION 1. That the action of the board of trustees of school district number thirty-two of the township of Watertown, of the county of Carver, in purchasing a site and contracting for the building of a school house thereon, and all other acts of said board of trustees relating thereto, be and the same is hereby legalized and made valid.

May issue bonds.

SEC. 2. The board of trustees of said school district number thirty-two, of Carver county, is hereby authorized to issue bonds for the purpose of payment of said site, and the building and finishing of a school house thereon, in a sum not exceeding three thousand five hundred dollars, to be issued in such denomina-
