of said extension; *Provided*, That the said company shall be bound to carry freight and passengers upon reasonable rates.

OHAPTER V.

An Act relating to the recording of deeds and other instruments by the Southern Minnesota Railroad Company.

Sucrem 1. How deeds or morigages of Southern Minnesota Bailroad Company are to be filed and recorded.

9. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That any mortgage, trust deed, or instrument in any way affecting the franchises of the Record of mort-Southern Minnesota Railroad Company, or any of its Regar, etc., to be property, may be filed and recorded in the office of of Usen. the Secretary of State of this State, and from the time of the filing of any such mortgage, deed, or instrument as aforesaid, the record thereof shall be notice to all persons of such lien or interest and of the contents of such mortgage, deed or instrument, and it shall not be necessary to record any such conveyance or instrument in the county in which the property affected is situated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
