

CHAPTER LXVIII.

March 2, 1866.*An Act authorizing the board of county commissioners of Washington county to pay a certain bond.*

- SECTION 1. County Commissioners of Washington county empowered to pay certain bond.
2. Authorizes proceedings of board of County Commissioners.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

May pay bond.

SECTION 1. That the board of county commissioners of Washington county are hereby empowered and authorized to pay from the common county fund that certain bond issued to George M. Seymour on the 6th day of September, 1865, for the sum of seven hundred dollars, in part payment for a set of abstract books, purchased by said county commissioners for the use of the county.

Legalizing purchase of books.

SEC. 2. That the acts and proceedings of the Board of county commissioners of said county, in the purchase of said set of abstract books, are hereby in all respects legalized and confirmed. *Provided,* That said abstract books shall not be considered as part of the public records, but they shall be under the sole and exclusive control of the board of county commissioners of said county.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
