

## CHAPTER LXXX.

March 2, 1868.

*An Act to revive, amend and continue an act entitled "An act to incorporate the Boston and Minnesota Mining Company," approved March 3d, 1855, and to revive the corporation thereby created.*

- Enormous 1.** Revives act of Territorial Assembly relative to Boston Mining Company,  
**2.** Amends section one of said act, by naming certain parties to constitute the corporation.  
**3.** When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Revives powers  
of Boston Mining  
Company.

**SECTION 1.** That the act of the Legislative Assembly of the late Territory of Minnesota, entitled "An act to incorporate the Boston and Minnesota Mining Company," approved March third, eighteen hundred and fifty-five, and the corporation thereby created, be and the same are hereby revived and continued, and the same act amended as herein provided: *Provided*, That each stockholder shall be liable to the amount of stock held or owned by him.

Amends section 1  
of former act.

**SEC. 2.** That section one of said act be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

That C. D. Gilfillan, R. F. Crowell, Albert Edgerton, Monroe Nichols, Henry L. Moss, J. E. Thompson, and their associates, shall be and are hereby constituted and made a body politic and corporate by the name and style of the "Boston and Minnesota Mining Company," and by that name shall be capable in law of suing and being sued, pleading and being impleaded, answering and being answered unto, defending and being defended in all courts and places whatsoever, in all manner of actions, suits, complaints and causes whatsoever, and may have a common seal, and alter the same at pleasure, and by said name shall be capable of purchasing, holding and conveying any estate or property, real or personal, for the use and benefit of said corporation. Said corporators may elect in such manner

as they may determine, all necessary officers, fix their compensation and define their duties, ordain and establish by-laws for the proper government and regulation of the affairs of said company, and alter and repeal the same, and employ all such agents, mechanics and laborers as they shall think proper.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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## CHAPTER LXXXI.

*An Act to fix the rate of Boomage to be charged by the St. Croix Boom Corporation for the period of two years.* February 23, 1866

SECTION 1. Fixes rate of boomage charged by the St. Croix Boom Corporation.

2. When act to take effect.

WHEREAS, The persons engaged in the logging business on the St. Croix River and the St. Croix Boom Corporation have come to an understanding and agreement, that said corporation for the coming two years, may charge and collect eighty-five cents per thousand feet for all logs and other timber sorted out, rafted, and made ready for delivery, and desire such legislation as will make said understanding and agreement binding and irrevocable for said term of two years, Therefore, Preamble.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the St. Croix boom corporation, organized under and pursuant to chapter forty-one of the session laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-six, en-
