CHAPTER X.

An Act to provide an appropriation of money for the completion and furnishing of a building for the accommodation and education of the deaf, dumb and blind.

March 5, 1867

SECTION 1.—Appropriates a sum of money for building for Deaf and Dumb.

2.—When act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The sum of thirty-eight thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the completion and furnishing of the building now in course of erection, for the accommodation and education of the deaf, dumb and blind, under and by virtue of section one of an act entitled an act to provide for the erection of a building for the accommodation and education of the deaf, dumb and blind, approved February fourteenth, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and the State Auditor is hereby directed to draw warrants for said amount, upon the certificates of the Governor, or President of the Board of Directors of the Deaf, Dumb and Blind Institute.

Appropriation

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
