

## CHAPTER OIII.

March 9, 1867,

*An Act to amend chapter sixteen of the General Statutes, relating to licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors.*

SECTION 1.--Amends chapter 16 of general statutes referring to licenses.

2 --When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section four of chapter sixteen of the general statutes, be amended by striking out the following words, in lines four and five of said section: "From which an intention to evade the provisions of this chapter appears," and by inserting in lieu thereof the following words: "shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and."

Amendment

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER CIV.

*An Act to amend section twenty-eight of chapter sixty-four, General Statutes, in relation to the terms of the district court in the fourth judicial district.*

SECTION 1.--Specifies the periods at which terms of district court are to be held in the several counties in the fourth judicial district.
