## CHAPTER XIX.



An Act to amend title 6 of chapter thirty-four of the General Statutes, relating to insurance companies.

Secretal 1-Amendment of chapter 84, of general statutes by providing for the furnishing of blanks by state treasurer to insurance companies.

2-When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That title 6 of chapter thirty-four of the General Statutes be amended by adding the following sections, viz:

Duties of State

SECTION 1. The state treasurer shall, at his own expense, furnish all fire insurance companies applying for the same, with the necessary printed blanks conforming to section 117 of this chapter; and he shall, in a book to be by him provided, keep a distinct and complete record of all the statements accepted and upon which authority has been granted in accordance with section 117 and 118 of this chapter, exhibting all the essential points in each case which book shall be open and subject to public examination.

SEC. 2. For the services required to be rendered by the provisions of this title, the state treasurer shall receive a fee of five dollars, to be paid by the companies, for each statement made and accounted.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
