

CHAPTER XLIV.

March 8, 1867*An Act to amend chapter 11 of the General Statutes relating to taxes.*

SECTION 1.—Regulates compensation to publishers for advertising certain matters.

2.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section 67 of chapter 11 of the general statutes be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 67. There shall hereafter be allowed to the publishers of newspapers, for advertising the delinquent and forfeited lists of the several counties, the sum of twenty cents for each description, and whenever more than one government subdivision or tract of land or town lot shall be included in a single descriptive sentence the same shall be deemed one description. *Provided,* That on and after the first day of April in each year the county auditor shall charge upon each tract of land which he is required to advertise, the cost of said advertisement.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
