

whose duty it shall be thereupon to draw a warrant for the certified amount upon the state treasurer in favor of said publisher.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LV.

An Act to amend chapter five of the General Statutes in relation to the printing and distribution of the laws and documents.

March 7, 1867

SECTION 1.—Amendment of chapter 5 of general statutes in regard to public printing.

2.—When act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section four of chapter five of the general statutes be amended by adding thereto the following clause: "And it is further provided that if any bids for the printing or binding of any class or classes of work provided for this chapter are at higher rates than in the opinion of the commissioners of printing, the same could be obtained elsewhere, it shall be the duty of said commissioners to reject any and all such bids, and provide by private contract, under the provisions of this chapter in all other respects, for the execution of the work specified in such rejected proposals."

Amendment

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
