

CHAPTER LVI.

An Act to provide for the distribution of the statutes in certain cases. March 7, 1867.

SECTION 1.—Secretary of state to deliver copies of statutes, etc., to certain officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby directed to deliver one copy of the general statutes, and of the session laws, to each of the following officers, to wit: To the United States circuit judge; to the United States district judge; to the clerk of each of the United States courts; to the United States marshal.

CHAPTER LVII.

An Act to provide for recording deeds and mortgages, to and from railroad companies and other corporations. February 27 '67

SECTION 1.—Provides for conveyance of certain deeds and mortgages.

2.—Secretary of state to transmit to register of deeds certified copies of abstracts.

3.—Proceedings to be taken when mortgage discharged.

4.—Fees of secretary of state and register of deeds.

5.—When act shall take effect.
