

several instruments hereinbefore mentioned, as registers of deeds are allowed by law for recording like instruments, which shall be paid by the party applying to have any such instrument recorded.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LVIII.

An Act to amend "An act to provide for recording deeds and mortgages to and from railroad companies and other corporations, approved February 27, 1867." March 6, 1867

SECTION 1.—Amends act in reference to railroad companies, etc.

2.—Repeal of original acts in reference to corporations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That whenever any deed of trust, mortgage or incumbrance shall be made by any railroad company, of or upon their road, lands or property situated in more than one county, it shall be lawful to have the same recorded in the office of the secretary of state, in a book provided for that purpose; and all records heretofore or hereafter so made shall have the same effect as if recorded in the proper county where such lands or property may be situated, or such road located or constructed.

Amendment

SEC. 2. That the act to provide for recording deeds and mortgages to and from railroad companies and other corporations, approved February 27, 1867, is hereby repealed.
