

## CHAPTER LX.

*An Act to amend section forty of title four of chapter sixty-six of the General Statutes, relating to civil actions.* March 7, 1867

SECTION 1.—Amends chapter 66 of general statutes by providing when actions to be tried.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section forty, of title four, of chapter sixty-six, of the general statutes be amended so as to read as follows: Amendment

*Section 40.* In all other cases the action shall be tried in the county in which the parties, or one of them, reside, at the commencement of the action, or if none of the parties reside in this state, the same may be tried in any county which the plaintiff may designate in his complaint; *provided, however,* that if an action is brought in the district court for the recovery of any sum not exceeding fifty dollars it must be commenced and tried in the county where the defendant resides, if a resident of this state, subject, however, to the power of the court to change the place of trial as provided by law.
