

CHAPTER LXIII.

An Act to amend section eight of chapter eighty-six of the General Statutes, in relation to appeals in civil actions. March 1, 1867,

SECTION 1.—Amends certain sections of chapter 86 of general statutes.

2.—When act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter eighty-six, of the general statutes is hereby amended so that subdivision fourth of said section, shall read as follows: Amendment
Fourth. From an order granting or refusing a new trial; or from an order sustaining or overruling a demurrer.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXIV.

An Act to amend section eighty-two, title ten, of chapter seventy-three of the General Statutes of Minnesota, relating to witnesses and evidence. March 9, 1867

SECTION 1.—Actions brought on promissory notes, possession of note to be prima facie evidence.

2.—When act shall take effect.
