CHAPTER LXIII.

An Act to amend section eight of chapter eighty-six of March 1, 1867, the General Statutes, in relation to appeals in civil actions.

Section 1. Section eight of chapter eighty-six, of the general statutes is hereby amended so that sub- Amendment division fourth of said section, shall read as follows: Fourth. From an order granting or refusing a new trial; or from an order sustaining or overruling a demurrer.

CHAPTER LXIV.

An Act to amend section eighty-two, title ten, of chapter seventy-three of the General Statutes of Minneseta, relating to witnesses and evidence.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section eighty-two, title ten, of chapter seventy-three of the general statutes of Minnesota be amended so as to read as follows:

Amendment

Section 82. In actions brought on promissory notes or bills of exchange by the indorser, the possession of the note is prima facis evidence that the same was indorsed by the person by whom it purports to be indorsed, and every written instrument purporting to have been signed or executed by any person shall be proof that it was so signed or executed, until the person by whom it purports to have been signed or executed shall deny the signature or execution of the same by his oath or affidavit; but this section shall not extend to instruments purporting to have been signed or executed by any person who shall have died previous to the requirement of such proof.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
