CHAPTER LXXXV.

*An Act in relation to pleadings in actions by or against foreign corporations.* February 27, '67

SECTION 1.—Foreign corporations, how sued.

2.—Repeals inconsistent acts.

3.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. In actions in any court of this state, by or against any foreign corporation, it shall, in any pleading, be a sufficient allegation that the plaintiff or defendant is a corporation, to aver substantially that the plaintiff or defendant, as the case may be, is a corporation, duly organized and created, under the laws of the state by which it may have been incorporated. Foreign corporation, how sued

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
