

CHAPTER XVIII.

An Act to authorize county commissioners to reimburse sheriffs for expenses incurred in transporting insane persons to the insane asylum in this state. March 7, 1867

SECTION 1.—Allows additional compensation to sheriffs in case of insane persons in their charge.

2.—By whom extra fees paid.

3.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The county commissioners in any county from which an insane person has been, or may hereafter be transported to the insane asylum of this state, be and are hereby authorized to allow their sheriff additional fees and charges above what is now allowed by law, when they deem such additional fees right and just. Fees

SEC. 2. All such extra fees and charges to be paid by the proper county and in the same manner as other county charges. Fees—how paid

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
