

SEC. 5. Any damages sustained by reason of laying out and opening of said road shall be assessed and determined by said commissioners, and shall be paid by the county in which said damages shall be so assessed. Damages

SEC. 6. Said commissioners shall cause an accurate plat and map of the survey and location of said road to be made, which, together with a statement of their appraisal of damages, shall be filed in the office of the county auditor in each of said counties, and thereupon the establishment of said road shall be deemed complete, and the supervisors of the several towns through which said road shall pass, shall cause to be opened and worked so much of said road as shall lie within their respective towns upon being notified by the county auditor of the proper county, that such plat has been filed as above described. Plat to be filed

SEC. 7. The expenses of surveying, locating and establishing said road, shall be paid by the counties through or in which said road shall run, in proportion to the distance it shall run in said counties respectively. Expenses, how defrayed

SEC. 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER OXVI.

An Act to locate a state road from Paynsville, in Stearns county, to Greenleaf, in Meeker county. February 26, '67

- SECTION 1.—Nominates commissioners.
 2.—Provides for organization.
 3.—Locates road.
 4.—Powers of Commissioners.
 5.—Plat to be filed.
 6.—When act to take effect,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Nominates commissioners **SECTION 1.** That William H. Greenleaf, O. W. Pewtherer and William H. Blaisdell are hereby appointed commissioners, whose duty it shall be to locate and establish a state road from Paynsville, in Stearns county, to Greenleaf, in Meeker county.

Organization **SEC. 2.** Said commissioners shall, on some day subsequent to the passage of this act, and prior to the first day of October next, meet at some point on said proposed road, and proceed to perform the duties imposed by this act.

Location of road **SEC. 3.** Said road shall commence at a point on the main street of the village of Paynesville, and shall follow the most direct and feasible route by way of Union Grove, to the village of Greenleaf.

May employ assistants **SEC. 4.** Said commissioners are hereby empowered to employ one ax man, one chain man and one surveyor. Said ax man and chain man shall receive not exceeding two dollars, and said surveyor three dollars per day for their services in locating said road. The commissioners appointed by this act, shall receive for their services under the provisions of this act, a sum not exceeding two dollars per day, and the expenses incurred in the location of said road shall be borne by the counties through which said road shall pass.

Plat to be filed **SEC. 5.** The said commissioners shall, on or before the first day of November next, file with the auditors of the respective counties through which said road shall pass, the map and field notes of the survey of said road, and on the filing of the maps and field notes as aforesaid, the said road shall be deemed to be located and established.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
