

CHAPTER OXVIII.

An Act to locate a state road from Paynesville, Stearns county, to Big Stone Lake. February 25, 1867

- ENOTION 1.—Appoints three commissioners to locate road.
 2.—Commissioners' meeting—vacancy, how filled.
 3.—Expenses, how defrayed.
 4.—Commissioners to file plats with county auditor.
 4.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. J. L. Wait, John Johnson and Ole Peterson are hereby appointed commissioners to locate and survey a state road from Paynsville in Stearns county, via Lake Johanna to Big Stone Lake. Nominates com-
missioners

SEC. 2. Said commissioners may meet at Paynsville on any day subsequent to the passage of this act, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed upon them by the provisions of this act; and if any one of said commissioners shall be unable to act as such, the other two commissioners shall have power to appoint a substitute. Organization

SEC. 3. Each county through which such road passes shall pay the reasonable expense of locating the same in such county. Expenses, how
paid

SEC. 4. The commissioners hereby appointed shall as soon as practicable after locating said road, file an accurate plat of the same in the office of the county auditor of each of the counties through any portion of which said road shall pass, which plat shall be legal evidence of the location and existence of said road. Plat to be filed

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
