CHAPTER OXXV.

March 9, 1867

An Act to locate, survey and establish a state road from Belle Plaine to Young America, Carver county, and Washington Lake in Sibley county.

SECTION 1.—Nominates three commissioners.

2.—Provides for organization.

3.—May employ assistants.

4.—Flat to be filed.

5.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Commissioners

SECTION 1. That Sanford A. Hooper, — Ackerman and George Rafferty are hereby appointed commissioners to locate establish and survey a state road from a point in Sibley county opposite Belle Plaine, in the county of Scott, to Young America, in the county of Carver, and also a branch from said proposed line from such point thereon as said commissioners shall deem proper, to such point on the Faxon and Glencoe state road, as they may deem best, not more than one mile east of Washington Lake.

Organization

SEC. 2. Said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall on any day subsequent to the passage of this act, and prior to the first day of November, A. D. 1867, meet at Belle Plaine aforesaid, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed by this act.

May employ as-
sistants

SEC. 3. Said commissioners are hereby authorized to employ one surveyor, one axman and one chain-

man; *Provided*, Said commissioners shall receive three dollars per day for their services, the chainman and axeman shall not receive more than two dollars per day, nor the surveyor more than four dollars per day for their services under this act, which compensation shall be paid by the respective counties through which said road shall pass.

SEC. 4. Said commissioners shall on or before the fifteenth day of November next, file an accurate map and plat of said road in the offices of the county auditors in the respective counties through which said road shall pass, and thereafter said road shall be deemed to be located and established.
