

CHAPTER CXXVII.

An Act to locate, survey and establish a state road from La Crescent, in Houston county, to La Mode, in Winona county.

March 9, 1867

SECTION 1.—Nominates three commissioners.

2.—Provides for organization.

3.—How expenses to be defrayed.

4.—Plat to be filed.

5.—When act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That S. C. Dick, H. Gleason and H. A. Wiltse are hereby appointed commissioners, whose duty it shall be to locate and establish a state road commencing at the village of La Crescent, in the county of Houston, and passing through the town of New Hartford and the village of Pickwick to the village of La Mode, in the county of Winona.

Commissioners

SEC. 2. Said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall, on some day subsequent to the passage of this act and prior to the first day of August, A. D. 1867, meet at the house of S. C. Dick, in the town of New Hartford, and then proceed to locate, survey and open said road.

Organization

SEC. 3. The expenses of surveying, locating and establishing said road shall be paid by the counties through or in which said road shall run in proportion to the distance it shall run in said counties.

Expenses—how paid

SEC. 4. The map or plat or survey of said road shall be filed by said commissioners in the office of the several registers of deeds of the counties through which the road may pass, on or before the first day of November, A. D. 1867.

Plats to be filed

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved March 9, 1867.
