

## CHAPTER OXLI.

March 7, 1867

*An Act to authorize the Judge of the Probate Court of Meeker county to order a sale of real estate of Robinson Jones, deceased*

SECTION 1.—Confers power on Probate Judge to sell real estate.

2.—Administrator to execute bonds.

3.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

May sell real estate

SECTION 1. That the judge of the probate court of the county of Meeker is hereby authorized, whenever it shall be made to appear to his satisfaction that the interest of the heirs and all parties interested will be promoted thereby, to make an order of license authorizing the administrator of the estate of Robinson Jones deceased, to sell at public or private sale, any or all of the real estate of said deceased, upon such terms and conditions, and upon such notice as shall be deemed most to the interest and advantage of said estate.

May give bonds

SEC. 2. Before making such sale the administrator shall execute a bond to the judge of probate in such sum as the said judge shall direct, with two or more sureties, to be approved by the judge, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties in making such sale, and for a full accounting and faithful disposition of the proceeds thereof. When such sale shall be made the administrator shall make return thereof, and the judge of probate shall act and proceed thereon in the same manner as provided by chapter fifty-seven of the general statutes in cases of sale of real estate by administrators.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
