

CHAPTER OXLIV.

An act to authorize the conveyance of real estate in certain cases. March 9, 1867

SECTION 1—Authorizes the sale of real estate.

2—Guardians to account for money to judge.

3.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1. That the guardians appointed by the probate court of Ramsey county of the persons and estate of William A. Findly, Mary B. Latour, Joseph Coursoll, jr., and Elizabeth Coursoll, minors, is hereby authorized and empowered, with the approval of the judge of probate of said county, to bargain, sell, grant and convey at public or private sale any or all the real estate of said minors, situate, lying and being in the state of Minnesota. Guardian may sell real estate

SEC. 2. Said guardians shall account to said judge for all moneys received by them for said minors for such sale. To account to judge

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
